Disciple Now Frequently Asked Questions

What is D-Now?

D-Now stands for Disciple Now. It is a weekend long event for our students dedicated to creating deep rooted relationships and digging deeply into a specific area of discipleship for 6th-12th grade students.

What will we be doing at D-Now?

How much does it cost?

Early registration is only \$40 through March 14th. After March 14th, the price will go up to \$50.

When is drop off and pick up?

Check-in will open at 5:15pm on Friday evening. You will be able to drop your student off in the Legacy (big building) front foyer at that time. Students will stay in their host homes on Friday and Saturday nights, and you may pick them up Sunday morning after the 10:15am service. We would love for you to join us for Sunday worship at 10:15am!
